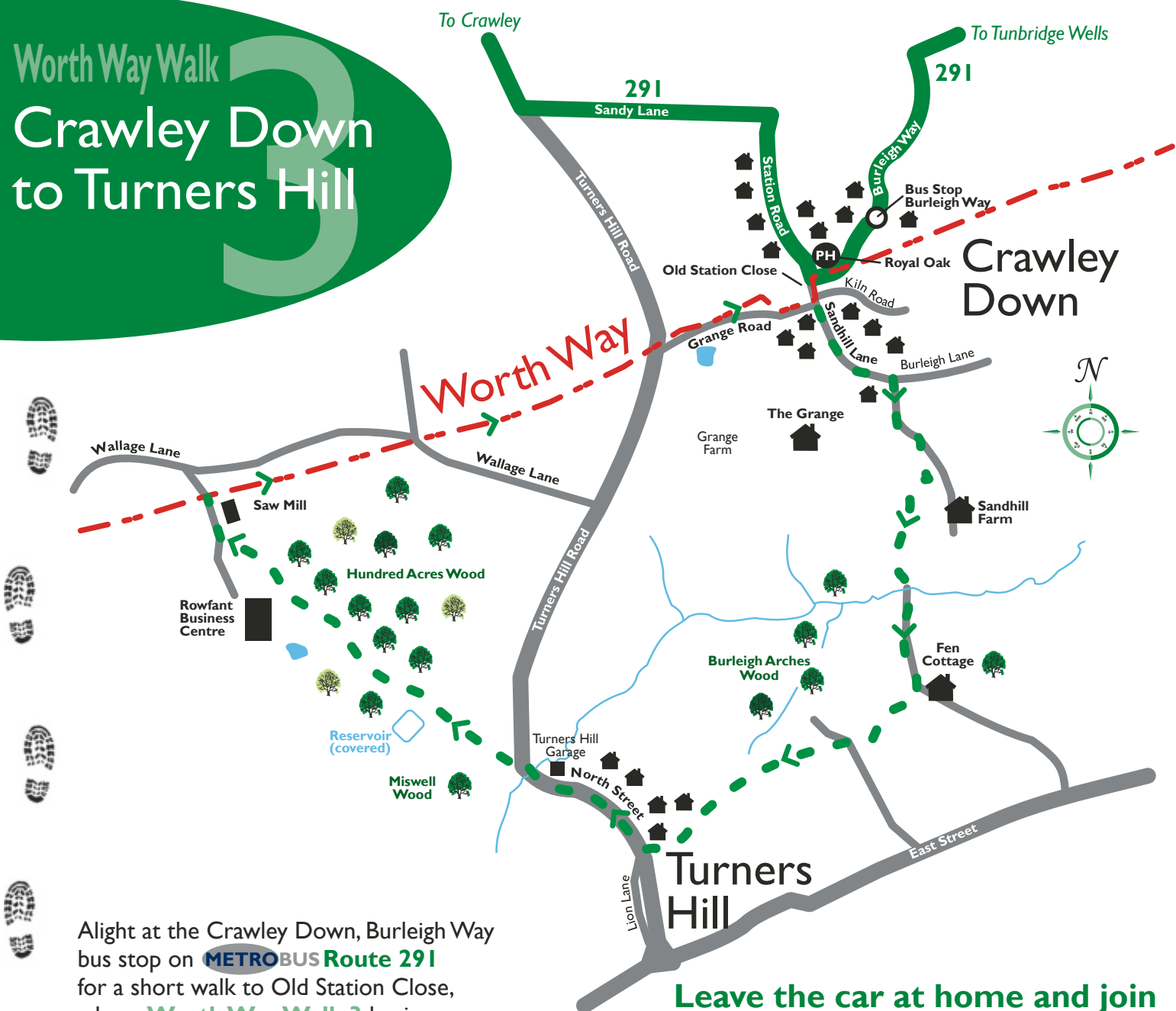


Worth Way Walk Crawley Down to Turners Hill



Alight at the Crawley Down, Burleigh Way bus stop on **METROBUS Route 291** for a short walk to Old Station Close, where **Worth Way Walk 3** begins...

Start: Old Station Close, Crawley Down.
Grid Ref: TQ 347 374

Distance: Approx 5.5 kms (3.5 miles)

Maps: OS Landranger 1:50 000, Sheet 187 & OS Explorer 1:25 000, Sheet 135

Refreshments: Local shops and public houses (open Sundays) in Crawley Down and Turners Hill.

Directions:

Starting at Old Station Close, walk past Kiln Road and up Sandhill Lane passing the entrance to The Grange and Sandhillgate Cottage. Don't go down Burleigh Lane, but bear right along the private road leading to Landfall and Sandhill Farm and Cottage. At the end of the lane turn right along and down an unsurfaced 'green lane'. Turn right at Fen Cottage. Cross straight over the surfaced lane into the open field opposite towards Turners Hill, one of the highest points in Sussex. Having crossed fields turn right along a driveway. You will come out facing Lion Lane. Turn right down Turners Hill and cross over just after Turners Hill Garage. Walk up the concrete track towards the covered reservoir. Bear right into Hundred Acres Wood. Once in the wood be careful not to wander along paths branching to the right. On leaving the wood, turn right past the sawmill and right again on to Worth Way. Follow Worth Way back to your starting point. Then catch the **291** bus back home.

Leave the car at home and join
Worth Way Walk 3
from **METROBUS Route 291**
