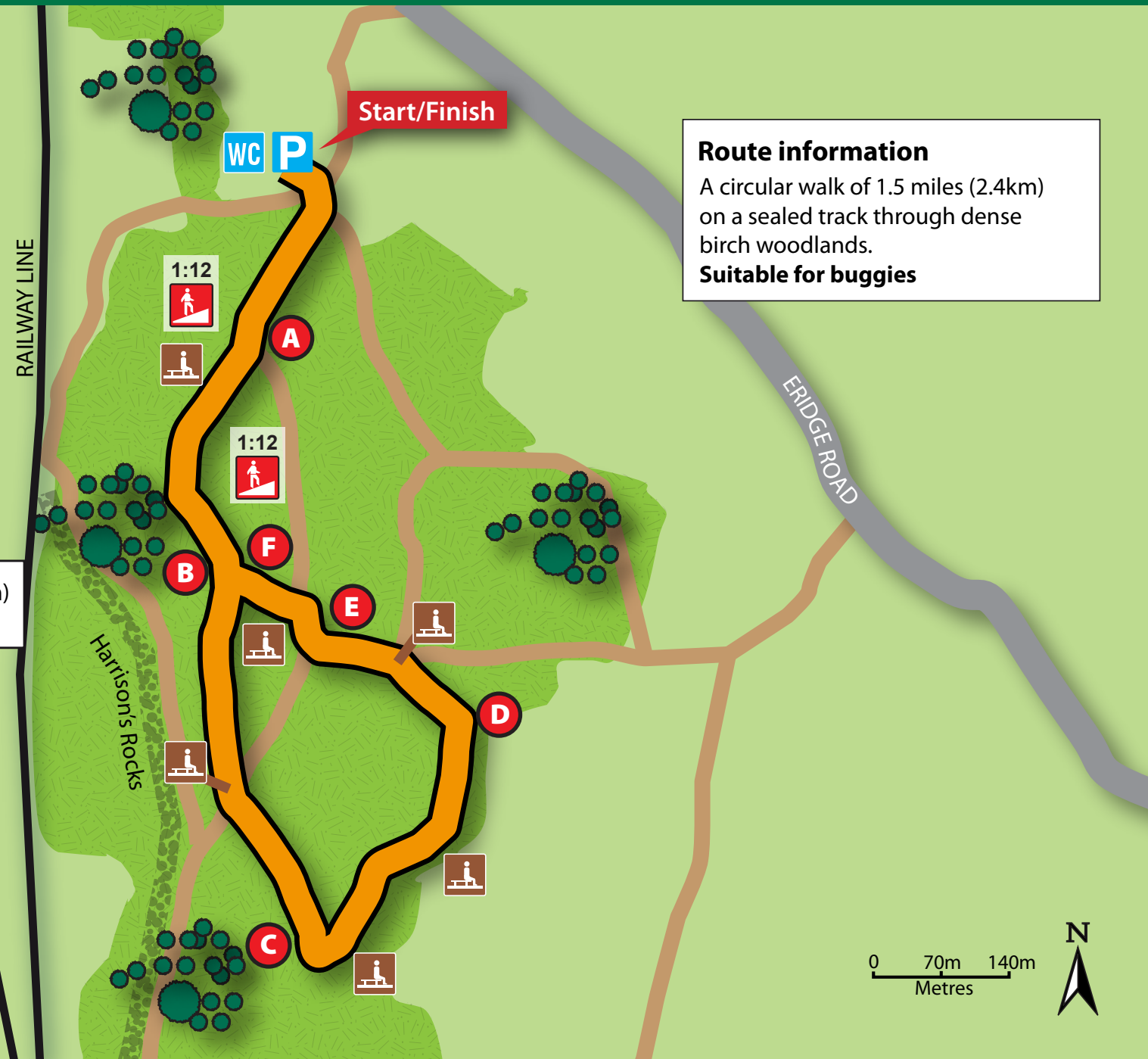


Birchden Wood



Route information
A circular walk of 1.5 miles (2.4km) on a sealed track through dense birch woodlands.
Suitable for buggies

Hard Surface-Fine - (stones up to 10mm)

How to get to Birchden Wood

Road: From the A264 west of Tunbridge Wells continue on the B2110 into Groombridge. Take the first exit at the mini roundabout onto Station Road. Cross the railway line over a bridge, take the right fork on to Eridge Road, the narrow entrance to the access track will be 200 metres on the right. Follow the track until you reach the car park.

Route description

Start: From car park go to large multi-sided roofed information board. Go through the rustic fencing and take the second right onto the wide surfaced track and head down the hill.

- A** Take right hand fork
- B** Continue straight at junction
- C** Turn left and continue on sealed track
- D** Turn left and continue on sealed track
- E** Turn right then almost immediately left
- F** Turn right at T junction and continue back to car park

Additional information

The site has a voluntary contribution car park with unmarked bays. Please ensure you don't block access when parking.

Opening times: All year.

Other facilities: Toilets.
