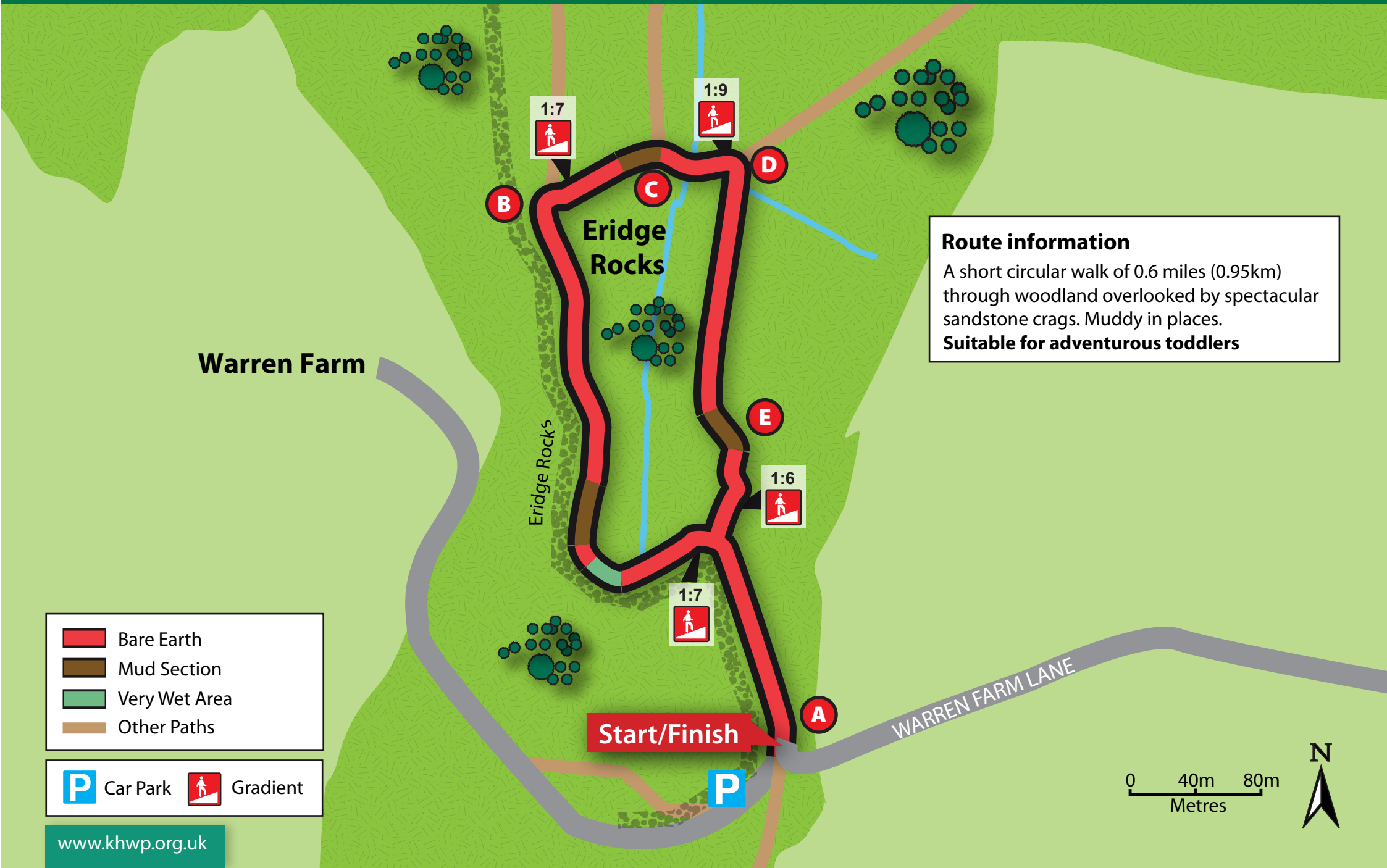


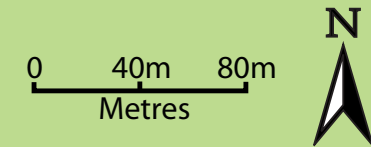
Eridge Rocks



Route information
A short circular walk of 0.6 miles (0.95km) through woodland overlooked by spectacular sandstone crags. Muddy in places.
Suitable for adventurous toddlers

- Bare Earth
- Mud Section
- Very Wet Area
- Other Paths

- Car Park
- Gradient





How to get to Eridge Rocks

Road: Head south from Tunbridge Wells on the A26. About 100 metres past the Nevill Crest and Gun Pub, turn right into a narrow lane immediately after the Holy Trinity Church. Continue up the private track to the small car park at the base of the rocks.

(close to Warren Farm Lane)

Route description

Start: Car park. Path begins on other side of field gate by information panel.

- A** Head along the path with the rocks on your left
- B** Look out for the power lines crossing the path. As soon as you have passed under them turn right, away from the rocks
- C** Continue on straight
- D** At junction turn right
- E** Keep going through wood until you get back to A

Additional information

The car park is free but has uneven surface and has limited spaces. Take care not to block access to any gates.

Opening times: All year.
