



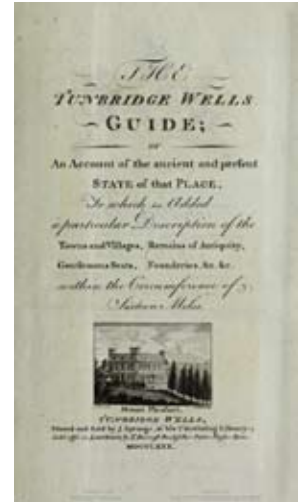
High Weald Hero Activity Card Characters in the High Weald - A Case Study



Jasper Sprange - 1746-1823 was a publisher based in Tunbridge Wells who produced many guides of places in the High Weald. His most famous being The Tunbridge Wells guide; or an account of the ancient and present state of that place.

This guide added a particular description of the towns and villages, gentlemen seats, remains of antiquity, founderies within the sixteen miles of the town.

In 1770 Jasper Sprange set up a publishing business in Tunbridge Wells. In a collection of 650 items printed by Sprange, mostly from the years 1794-97, which included adverts for entertainment, auction announcements, adverts for local tradesman, and a rich assortment of notices, labels, tickets, notices and official notices.
