

Caterpillar tortilla rolls

What you need

Tortilla wraps
Fillings of your choice

We used:

- ham
- cream cheese
- lettuce



How to make

Spread the wraps with a thin layer of cream cheese.

Lay some slices of ham on top to cover.

Cover the ham with lettuce.

Tip – don't make these layers too thick or the wrap will be difficult to roll up.

Carefully roll it up, this works best if you wrap it quite tightly so it stays together.

Now cut it into slices and lay them out on a plate in a caterpillar shape!

(For antennae, we used grapes stuck on cocktail sticks.)
